

BAYTREE ROSE FESTIVAL

23RD JUNE - 1ST JULY

There will be 2 classes in which you can enter, those being Best Single Bloom and Best Multi Stem Bloom.

In addition there will be an award for Best In Show.

The Rose Festival is free to enter and you may enter multiple roses in each category.

Each Single Stem Bloom entry must be displayed in a vase of your choice and be available for judging no later than 2pm on Saturday 23rd June.

All Multi Stem entries as above must be displayed in a vase of your choice and be available for judging no later than 2pm on Saturday 23rd June. In this category you may use up to but no more than 3 single blooms in your display.

Each entry must be accompanied with your own label clearly displaying the name of the rose or roses and your name.

Judging will take place behind closed doors on Saturday 23rd June.

When Baytree opens on Sunday 24th June at 10am the winning entrants will have rosettes placed in front of their rose exhibits.

All of the roses that have been entered will remain on display for the duration of the Rose Festival Week.

The judges decision is final.

The overall National Competition criteria requires that only single stem roses can be entered into the national competition. This National Competition which is managed by sungardening.co.uk has a top prize of £1000.

The best single stem rose as judged by ourselves will be entered into the National Prettiest Rose Competition for judging.
